

Governor Proclamation

WHEREAS, in 1974, Dorothy and Roger Hough founded Gateway to Learning upon realizing the need for more specialized education after having two children with intellectual and developmental disabilities; and,

WHEREAS, founded with the help of other families in the community, Gateway to Learning operated out of a church until a new building was constructed in 1986; and,

WHEREAS, in the 1980s and 1990s Gateway to Learning began providing continued learning opportunities, what we call Lifelong Learning, for adults who had transitioned out of the public school system; and,

WHEREAS, Gateway to Learning exclusively provides programming for adults aged 22 through life for adults to continue to learn, be active, and thrive in Chicagoland; and,

WHEREAS, Gateway to Learning provides support through a number of programming opportunities for adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities, including the 'Community Day Services' where they serve over 100 individuals each year to learn life and job skills; and,

WHEREAS, Gateway to Learning is celebrating 50 years of service (1974-2024) to over 2500 individuals in the intellectually and developmentally disabled community in Chicagoland at their RockABILITY fundraising event;

THEREFORE, I, JB Pritzker, Governor of the State of Illinois, do hereby proclaim April 19, 2024, Gateway to Learning Day in Illinois.
